The Registration Package contains important information regarding the terms and conditions of the Student's enrollment with Shift Dance Academy Ltd. (at times referred to herein as "Shift") in dance classes and participation in the 2026/2027 dance season which runs from the week of September 14, 2026 until June 5, 2027 (the "Term"). By signing and submitting the Registration Package, you are entering into a contract with Shift Dance Academy Ltd. for the Term. Among other things, you will be responsible for all costs and fees for the 2026/2027 season provided for in the contract described herein. These costs and fees are NON-REFUNDABLE.

2026/2027 Registration Fees*

- A one-time NON-REFUNDABLE registration fee will be processed at the time of registration.
 - Returning Students: \$140.00 + tax
 - New Students: \$150.00 + tax

*A one-time credit of \$100 will be applied towards September tuition for families choosing to use EFT as their annual method of payment.

Competitive & Exam Based Classes

- **Competition Fees:**
 - Each competitive class will register in a minimum of 1-5 different competitions over the course of the Term depending on their program (i.e., Performance, Pre-Competitive, Full Competitive). (Entry fees average \$75.00 + tax per group. Media Fees average \$55.00 + tax per dancer per competition).
 - Each Full Competitive dancer will also be charged a one-time \$120.00 + tax competition travel fee for out-of-town events.
 - Competition and travel fees will be the responsibility of the Parent/Guardian and differ based on the competition entered.
 - Competition entry, registration and travel fees are NON-REFUNDABLE.
 - Costume purchase and/or rental fees:
 - Each competitive class will require its own costume for the students to wear during performances and competitions. (Costumes cost an average \$185.00 + tax per group). Costumes will be received by the date of the competitive Preview Show on or around February 25, 2027.
 - Costume fees will be the responsibility of the Parent/Guardian and are NON-REFUNDABLE.
 - Costumes and accessories are the Student’s responsibility. The Student and their Parent/Guardian will be responsible for replacing any lost or damaged costume pieces or accessories, including any associated rush processing or delivery fees, and they will be charged accordingly for the replacement item.
- **Competition Sweatsuits/Tracksuits:**
 - Shift competition tracksuits/sweatsuits are required by each competitive student and are to be worn at every competition/performance. Shift tracksuits/sweatsuits are available for purchase through the Shift office. Information regarding ordering Shift competition tracksuits/sweatsuits will be communicated separately.
- **Competitive Class Fees:**
 - Each competitive class will be charged a \$20.00 + tax, one-time, NON-REFUNDABLE competition class fee., at the time of registration.
- **Exam Fees:**
 - Ballet exam fees are required for any dancer participating in a Royal Academy of Dance (“RAD”) examination, demonstration or award. Exam fees will differ based on the level of exam taken and range from approximately \$300.00 to \$550.00, + tax. Participation in an examination, demonstration, or class award is by invitation and will be discussed with you during the Term, if applicable.
 - Exams fees, if applicable, will be the responsibility of you/the Parent/Guardian and are NON-REFUNDABLE.
- **Bodysuit Fees:**
 - All students in an RAD ballet class will need to purchase a bodysuit to be worn in class and during exams.
 - Bodysuit fees will be the responsibility of you/the Parent/Guardian and are NON-REFUNDABLE.
- **Ballet Master Class Fees:**
 - Students invited to participate in a ballet examination, class award or demonstration will be required to register for Master Classes. Master Class fees are approximately \$45.00 per class + tax.
 - Master class fees will be the responsibility of you/the Parent/Guardian.

- **Recital Fees:**
 - **Holiday Recital**
 - **Performance Fee:** A one-time Performance Fee of \$55.00 + tax will be charged on October 2, 2026, to all dancers registered in participating classes of our Holiday Recital (December 2026). Includes digital copy of performance. Performance fees are NON- REFUNDABLE.
 - **Holiday Recital Costume Fees:** A \$45.00 + tax costume deposit will be charged to each dancer per class taken on October 2, 2026, with the balance being charged on or before November 25, 2026. Holiday Recital Costume fees are estimated to be approximately \$65.00 + tax per costume. Costumes will be received in time for the holiday recital. The number of routines and costumes will vary per person. These fees cover the cost of Holiday Recital Costume purchases/ rentals. All Holiday Recital Costume Fees are final and NON-REFUNDABLE.
 - **Year End Recital**
 - **Performance Fee:** A one-time Performance Fee of \$55.00 + tax will be charged on January 27, 2027, to participate in our year end recital in May 2027. Includes digital copy of performance. Performance fees are NON- REFUNDABLE.
 - **Recital Costume Fees:** A \$45.00 + tax costume deposit will be charged to each dancer per class taken as of January 27, 2027, to cover the cost of recital costume purchases/rentals. The balance of the recital costume fees will be charged on or before May 25, 2027. Recital Costume fees are approximately \$65.00 + tax per costume. Costumes will be received in time the Year End Recital. The number of routines and costumes will vary per person depending on the classes each student is enrolled in. All Year End Recital Costume Fees are final and NON-REFUNDABLE, regardless of whether the Student's recital costume(s) are purchased or rentals.

In the event the Student should decide to withdraw from one or more of their dance classes after registration, **SHIFT DANCE ACADEMY LTD.'s** cancellation policy for the 2026/2027 dance season is as follows:

Upon registration, September 2026 class fees (tuition) and registration fees are due and are NON-REFUNDABLE.

Competitive & Exam Based Classes

The **LAST** day to withdraw from any competition or exam-based class is by **October 2, 2026**.

To be eligible for cancellation, written notice by email, must be provided to the office and sent to info@shiftdance.ca by 5:00pm Pacific Time on October 2, 2026. After October 2, 2026, no cancellations will be accepted.

Revised tuition fee statements will be sent out, effective November 1, 2026, and remain in place for the duration of the Term.

**No changes will be made to class fees (tuition) and related fees for any classes dropped after October 2, 2026. This means that even if the Student no longer participates in a competition class or exam-based class after this date, you are still responsible for class fees (tuition) and all related Additional Fees that have already been committed to for the dropped class(es) for the rest of the 2026/2027 season. No refunds will be provided. We invite you to contact Shift to discuss further if you have questions and/or information concerning the Student's circumstances during the Term.*

Recreational Classes

The **LAST** day to withdraw from any recreational class is **January 20, 2027**.

Cancellations for dance classes are permitted up to 10 days before next payment date (first of the month), and are valid only during the period from September 14, 2026 to January 20, 2027.

To be eligible for cancellation:

- Written notice by email, must be provided to the office and sent to info@shiftdance.ca by 5:00pm Pacific Time the 20th day of the respective month at the latest.
- Revised tuition fee statements will be sent out, effective the next payment date, and remain in place for the duration of the Term.
- After January 20, 2027, no cancellations will be accepted.

**No changes will be made to class fees (tuition) and related fees for any classes dropped after January 20, 2027. This means that even if the Student no longer participates in a recreational class or classes after this date, you are still responsible for the class fees (tuition) and all related Additional Fees that have already been committed to for the dropped class(es) for the rest of the 2026/2027 season. No refunds will be provided. We invite you to contact Shift to discuss further if you have questions and/or information concerning the Student's circumstances during the Term.*

CONGRATULATIONS, you have been *invited* into the competitive dance division of Shift Dance Academy Ltd.! You have been selected to join this program based on your ability, attitude, and your passion for dance! In addition to new dance related opportunities, each student in the competitive division is expected to meet new levels of commitment, responsibility, and accountability.

Dancing in the Shift competitive program is a privilege. The competitive program is for dancers who are willing to commit to the demands of this stream of dance (in contrast with the lesser commitments of the recreational program). It is important that you regard yourself as a team member. As a competitive dancer, you are constantly in the spotlight. You are looked up to and admired by many of our recreational dancers, as well as your fellow competitive dancers. You are a representative of Shift both in the studio and in the community.

This Competitive Code of Conduct applies to each student enrolled in the Shift competitive program in the 2026/2027 dance season (i.e., Performance, Pre-competitive, and Full Competitive programs). Please read carefully before signing below. Failure to follow this Competitive Code of Conduct could result in serious consequences including but not limited to revocation of competition/performance rights and leading to expulsion.

- **Be Respectful and Treat Others The Way You Would Want to be Treated**

- Be mindful of how you communicate with other students, instructors, staff, and volunteers. You are expected to always communicate and interact with others in a respectful, appropriate, and kind manner. This requirement extends beyond the Shift studio and into the community including at events, school, and gatherings.
- Bullying, including cyber-bullying and gossip, and harassment is unacceptable.
- Discrimination and racism are not tolerated. We value equality and respect the rights of everyone.
- Bullying, harassment, discrimination of any kind, exclusionary or disrespectful behaviour are grounds for consequence and expulsion at the sole discretion of Shift.
- Competition etiquette is extremely important. The more supportive and encouraging the dancers are to each other and their fellow dancers, the better the experience for all! Please cheer and congratulate your peers, both from Shift and other studios, on a job well done! We are *all* a team- we support, encourage, and cheer for everyone.

- **Attendance and Commitment**

- The expectation is that you will prioritize your competitive dance commitments over your other extra-curricular commitments (e.g. other sports, music, or theatre productions, whether through school or otherwise) if faced with a scheduling conflict.
- Students are required to attend all classes, with the exception of family or medical emergencies. The office *must* be notified, by phone or email, of all absences.
 - Competition privileges may be revoked due to poor attendance.
 - Attendance is imperative in all classes contributing to the competition and/or exam class. Failure to attend supplementary classes (i.e., Ballet), will result in revoked performance privileges. Poor attendance may result in further consequences, e.g., expulsion and/or the Student not being invited back into the competitive program the next year.
- Participation in each class is required.
 - If you are unable to participate due to injury, a doctor or physio note is required with specific recommendations of treatment. If the injury is ongoing, the dancer will need to provide a note clearing them to dance.
 - The expectation is that dancers will still attend class while injured. They will sit and watch to take in any choreography or material, so it is not missed.

- Attendance the week prior to any competition, performance and/or ballet examination is *extremely important*. **The last competitive class before a competition or performance for each class the Student is enrolled in is mandatory. Failure to attend these classes will result in a loss of competitive rights for the dancer at that event.** If a dancer is ill, but not contagious, or injured, it is important that they still attend class to watch for any changes that may need to be made. It is imperative for the group to remain unified and clear of the choreography before a performance or competition.
- Extra rehearsals may be scheduled should a dance require extra preparation for an upcoming performance. These rehearsals are for the benefit of the group and attendance is *mandatory*. We will provide as much notice as possible.
- Each class is a team, in which all members are needed for the group to dance well. Dancers invited into the competitive level are committed to attending all competitions with their classes.
- **If the Student misses a competition (whether in whole or in part), they will *not* be allowed to participate in the following competitions or performance opportunities.** This means that if the Student misses a competition, they will not be permitted to participate in the next competition or performance, which may effectively mean they are excluded from competitions for the balance of the dance season and the Year End Recital. NO REFUNDS of any kind whatsoever will be provided in these circumstances. Non-attendance at a competition may also result in further consequences including potentially not being invited by Shift to participate in the competitive program at Shift the next year.
- **Arrive On Time**
 - It is extremely important to arrive on time as it ensures the dancers have time for a proper warm-up, which can help eliminate and prevent injury.
 - Dancers who arrive after warm-up will be asked to sit on the side and stretch until their instructor feels they are warm enough to join their class, without risk of injury.
 - At competition, dancers are required to arrive at a *minimum of 1.5 hours prior* to the performance time (unless otherwise specified by their instructor). They must arrive ready to dance with their hair and stage make-up finished. We suggest they review their dance as a team, in order to perform their best dance on stage.
 - Competition can run early and will not wait for any latecomers! We suggest leaving yourself extra time to arrive promptly at the competition venue.
- **Be Prepared**
 - Bring your water bottle with you! It is important to stay hydrated when exercising as much as dancers do.
 - Proper attire is expected to be worn to each class. It is important for instructors to be able to see the body alignment of each dancer, in order to give the appropriate corrections to prevent injury.
 - Failure to wear the specified attire may result in the loss of participation in class.
 - Please see our Studio Attire page on our website www.shiftdance.ca for full details.
 - Specific footwear is designed for each style of dance and should be worn in the appropriate classes.
 - Please see Studio Attire page on our website for further details.
 - Hair is to be pulled back, securely off the dancer's face, at all times. In ballet, hair is to be worn in a ballet bun.
 - Costumes and accessories are the Student's responsibility. The student and their parent/guardian will be responsible for replacing any lost or damaged costume pieces, including any associated rush delivery fees, and will be charged accordingly for the replacement item.
 - In the event a dancer forgets a costume or accessory, that dancer may not compete based on the instructor's discretion.
- **Social Media**
 - Engagement is expected to be positive and appropriate across all social media channels and in accordance with Shift Dance Academy Ltd.'s standards and guidelines.
 - Engaging in social media that is harmful, negative, or damaging to any Shift staff, partners, students, and instructors will result in consequences up to and including program expulsion.

- **Cellphones And Personal Belongings**
 - *Cellphones are not permitted for use in or during classes at any time.* Photos and videos are not allowed to be taken in class, due to the privacy of other dancers. We do not suggest bringing valuables to dance; however, should a dancer need to do so, they are welcome to leave valuables in the office with a staff member.
 - If a dancer fails to understand this requirement, cellphones will be kept by a staff member, in the office, for the remainder of the day.
 - Videotaping and photography are strictly prohibited at all competitions. Failure to comply with the competition rules will result in *disqualification* of the group/individual and possibly Shift as a whole.
 - If a group is disqualified due to the videotaping by a dancer's friend or family, that dancer will not compete in the following competitions, to avoid putting the class at risk of future disqualification.
- **Vandalism**
 - Vandalism of any facilities and/or equipment of Shift Dance Academy Ltd. is unacceptable. During any outside rehearsals, competitions, and recital, our dancers are expected to treat the property and facilities with respect.
 - You will be responsible for any costs or repairs related to damage of any kind.
- **Zero-Tolerance Alcohol, Drugs, and Vaping**
 - This policy is *strictly* enforced. Dancers under the influence or in possession of drugs, alcohol, or vapes at dance, competition, group events, or recitals will be disciplined.
 - Consequence up to and including program suspension and/or expulsion from Shift Dance Academy.

We encourage students to strive for their best, mature artistically, and reach their potential goals as a dancer and performer. While we recognize that everyone develops at different speeds, it is important to keep in mind that we are looking for a combination of attitude and ability. We are a team that encourages and supports one another to dance our way to our goals, as individuals, and as a group!

At Shift Dance Academy Ltd., we believe in nurturing not only dancers but also ensuring that the environment in which your student dances is a positive and respectful one for our dancers and the entire Shift community. To help ensure that Shift remains a safe, inclusive, and encouraging environment for all, we require parents/guardians of students enrolled with Shift Dance Academy Ltd. to adhere to the following Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct. This Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct outlines the expectations and obligations of all parents/guardians of students enrolled in Shift for the 2026/2027 season and regardless of whether they are the primary parent contact with Shift for the purposes of their student's enrollment with Shift.

Please read carefully before signing below. Failure to adhere to this Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct could result in serious consequences for you and/or your Student with respect to their participation in dance at Shift, including but not limited to the issuance of a warning, temporary suspension, or, in severe cases, dismissal from the studio, as may be determined at the sole discretion of Shift. Should you have questions or require clarification, you are invited to contact the Shift office to discuss further prior to signing in the signature line below.

Respect:

Parents/guardians must conduct themselves with courtesy and respect toward all students, parents, instructors, staff, and volunteers, both within and outside the studio environment, including at competitions, performances, and related events and settings. This includes treating those from competing dance studios with courtesy and respect.

Parents/guardians must support and uphold a safe, inclusive atmosphere that is free from discrimination, harassment, bullying, gossip, making disparaging comments regarding Shift and the Shift community (e.g. students, their families, instructors, staff, volunteers, etc.), and disrespectful behaviour of any kind.

Parents/guardians must accept and respect the choreography process and understand that our instructors may design their choreography so as to include a section in a dance where one or a few dancers are featured over others. This is the nature of performing arts and a reflection of the creative process of the choreographer.

Communication:

Parents/guardians are responsible for staying informed of important dates, information, and requirements relating to the dance season by reviewing all official studio communications in a timely manner, including, but not limited to, emails, newsletters, social media updates, and posted announcements. Should questions arise or if clarification is sought, parent/guardians are responsible for raising such questions promptly with the Shift office.

Parents/guardians are to communicate any concerns, questions, or issues directly with the Shift administrative office in a respectful, professional, and constructive manner, using appropriate channels such as phone or email, while avoiding airing criticism in front of other dancers or their families. Parents/guardians are not to raise issues or disagreements with other dancers, instructors, or staff publicly, nor are they to make disparaging comments about Shift or those in the Shift community or engage in gossip or otherwise inappropriate conduct. This includes ensuring social media and other electronic communications are appropriate and respectful. Aggressive, rude, threatening or intimidating communications from parents/guardians directed at students or their families, Shift staff, instructors, volunteers, or others from competing dance studios will not be tolerated.

Attendance:

Parents/guardians are responsible for the on-time arrival of their student(s) for all scheduled classes (and competitions and performances, as may be applicable). Parent/guardians must also ensure their Student(s) is picked up promptly afterward.

Parents/guardians must notify the Shift office by phone or email in advance of any absences or late arrivals. It is further understood that repeated absences may negatively impact the student’s progress and may affect their eligibility to participate in performances or other studio-related activities.

Dance is a team sport and attendance at all rehearsals is crucial for a successful group performance. Parents/guardians enrolling their student(s) with Shift acknowledge and agree that attendance at all scheduled competitions, recitals, and other performances is mandatory.

Parents/guardians of students in any of the Shift competitive programs (i.e., Performance, Pre-competitive, Full competitive) must accept and respect that the expectation is that students in Shift’s competitive program will prioritize their competitive dance commitments over other extra-curricular commitments (e.g. other sports, music, or theatre productions, whether through school or otherwise) if faced with a scheduling conflict. We invite parents/guardians who have questions or concerns about this level of commitment to contact the Shift office before registration to discuss whether the competitive program is right for their student and family.

Parents/guardians must also accept that participating in Shift’s competitive program is a privilege which may be revoked for failure to comply with the terms and conditions of the Registration Package.

Studio Space/ Etiquette:

Parents/guardians must remain within designated waiting areas and strictly refrain from entering any studio spaces that are restricted to authorized personnel or students only. Parents/guardians are responsible for supervising any siblings, caregivers, and/or other family members in attendance to ensure they conduct themselves respectfully toward studio property and all individuals present.

Financial Responsibilities:

Parents/guardians are responsible for ensuring that all fees and costs agreed upon and described in the Registration Package are paid in full and on time. Unless expressly provided for in the Registration Package, all costs and fees for classes, registration, costumes, competitions, travel, performance and recital fees are non-refundable once committed.
